Crime Type	Key Search Terms Used	Examples
Human Trafficking	Trafficking, human, sale, sell, children, recruitment, trade, slavery, women	"trafficking of persons especially children" S/RES/2119 (2013)
Human Smuggling	Flow(s), movement, border, smuggling, illicit	"illegal smuggling of migrants" S/RES/2380 (2017)
Drug Trafficking	Drug(s), Narcotics	"illegal drugs activities" S/RES/1333 (2000)
Arms Trafficking	Arms, armed, transfer, flow, illicit, weapon, sale, traffick, trade	"illegal flow of small arms" S/RES/1318 (2000)
Resource Trafficking	Resource, water, minerals, timber, wood, ivory, gold, oil, diamond, petrol, ivory	"the illegal exploitation of natural resources, illicit trade in such resources" S/RES/2117 (2013)
Wildlife Trafficking	Wildlife, poach, fish	"the linkage between the illegal exploitation of natural resources, including poaching and illegal trafficking of wildlife, illicit trade in such resources" S/RES/2360 (2017)
Armed robbery/ theft	Theft, robbery, steal	"to create the conditions for a durable eradication of piracy and armed robbery at sea off the coast of Somalia" S/RES/2299 (2016)
Piracy	Piracy, maritime	"undertaking measures to suppress acts of piracy" S/RES/2111 (2013)
Goods Trafficking	Goods, artefacts, art, cultur(e/al)	"including from the trafficking of arms, persons, drugs, and artefacts, and from the illicit trade in natural resources including gold and other precious metals and stones, minerals, wildlife, charcoal and oil, as well as from kidnapping for ransom and other crimes including extortion and bank robbery" S/RES/2253 (2015)
Financial Crime	Financial, financing, fund, money laundering, fraud	"to more effectively combat transnational organized crime, in particular drug trafficking and money laundering" S/RES/2103 (2013)
Cyber Crime	Internet, online, cyber, tech, communications	"Expressing its concern over the use of various media, including the Internet, by Al-Qaida, Usama bin Laden, and the Taliban, and their associates, including for terrorist propoganda and inciting terrorist violence" S/RES/1617 (2005)
Terrorism	Terror, armed groups, Al Qaeda, Da(')esh	"the most serious threats to peace and security and that any acts of terrorism are criminal and unjustifiable regardless of their motivations" S/RES/1989 (2011)
Kidnapping	Kidnap(ping), abduct(ion), hostage, ransom	"strongly condemning the incidents of kidnapping and hostage taking with the aim of raising funds or gaining political concessions" S/RES/2164 (2014)
