The event will showcase new publications by the GI-TOC that are part of its Infrastructure of Integrity series.

The first, entitled *Political Economy of Organized Corruption and Anti-Corruption*, looks at the factors that enable organized corruption to flourish in the region and the impact that this has. The second, entitled *Western Balkans Anti-Corruption Pledge Monitor*, reviews implementation of governmental anti-corruption pledges made at the London Summit of the Berlin Process in 2018 as well as other relevant anti-corruption commitments.

The reports will be introduced by the authors Uglješa Ugi Zvekić and Suncana Roksandić, commented upon by an international expert panel, and then discussed with the audience.
