IASOC is awarding prizes in four categories in 2022:



Best Journal Article

published in **Trends in Organized Crime** and **Journal of Illicit Economies and Development**

The Best Journal Article recognizes the best article published in Trends in Organized Crime and the Journal of Illicit Economies and Development (JIED) for each year. Nominated articles must be published no earlier than 2021. Journal articles must be nominated by persons other than the authors.



Best Ph.D. Thesis / Dissertation

Excellent Ph.D. theses or dissertations defended successfully three years before the year of the award. Nominated theses and dissertations must have been defended after 1 June 2019. Can be nominated by the candidate's supervisor or department chair.




Best Book

The Best Book recognizes the best book or monograph on the broadly defined area of organized crime. Books may be published on commercial or academic presses; self-published books are ineligible. Nominated books must be published no earlier than 2019. Books can be nominated by book publishers or author(s). Self nominations are welcome.



Distinguished Scholar

Scholars who have made significant advances in the study of organized crime throughout their careers. Must be nominated by others; no self nominations, please.



To nominate someone please fill out **this form**.

You will be asked to include a letter of nomination, stating the reasons why the work or person ought to be considered for the IASOC prize. In the case of Article and Thesis nominations, you will be asked to include a copy of the work. For the publication prizes and the thesis prize, works must be published or defended within the three years prior to the closing of the nomination cycle (e.g. to nominate in 2022, the publication or thesis must have been published or defended after 1 June 2019).

**All nominations are due by 30 June 2022.
All nominations and nominated works must be available in English.**
