## ONLINE CHILD SEXUAL EXPLOITATION: A GLOBAL PERSPECTIVE OF HOW VULNERABLE CHILDREN ARE VICTIMIZED ONLINE





Research has tracked a clear correlation between the growing internet penetration, online gaming, social media and mobile devices with the increase in online child sexual exploitation (OCSE). Victims are particularly vulnerable to abuse when there are low levels of digital awareness among children and their parents, as parents effect limited or no controls on internet usage.

This event will discuss the different forms of OCSE, the criminal actors involved, its transnational dynamics, as well as preventive strategies and responses from national and regional bodies as well as international organizations.
